

Environmental Policy Statement

Condron Concrete Works is a 100% Irish owned Private Company founded in 1969 by John Condron. It is located just outside Tullamore, Co. Offaly, Ireland. The Company manufactures Concrete Pipes, Manholes and Gulley Traps, Concrete Roof Tiles and Accessories, and plastic pipes and ducting.

This Environmental Policy Statement sets out our approach to environmental management and is a key aim in our company's vision. Our priority is to deliver a sustainable environment, by improving our environmental performance, to leave a sustainable environmental legacy for future generations.

We expect and encourage everyone who works for Condron Concrete, as well as those who supply and support Condron Concrete, to apply the following key principles:

- We will comply with all relevant environmental and social legislation and regulatory requirements
- We will identify our environmental impacts and manage these appropriately
- We will take action to prevent pollution to land, air and water which may occur as a result of our operations
- We will purchase and use natural resources in a responsible and sustainable manner
- We will reduce the amount of materials we use wherever possible and minimise the amount of waste we produce, by for example, encouraging the return of timber pallets for re-use and using recycled plastic content in our production facilities
- We will reduce the amount of energy we use wherever possible. For example, we recycle
 heat and moisture from our roof tile curing chambers using heat exchangers to reduce gas
 energy consumption.
- We will manage our land sustainably and consider the impacts on biodiversity
- We will become more energy efficient and reduce our carbon emissions by continually reviewing our procedures and precuring the latest plant and equipment for the manufacture of our products
- We will provide our employees with the relevant competencies and training to deliver our policies
- We will encourage our suppliers to adopt suitable relevant environmental policies
- In our offices, we will encourage staff to reduce paper usage by printing less and using email and internet whenever possible to share documents
- We will encourage staff to switch off computers, screens and printers when not required Also ensure communal equipment such as photocopies and printers are switched off overnight
- We will provide recycling facilities in all offices and factories for card, paper, plastics, and metal
